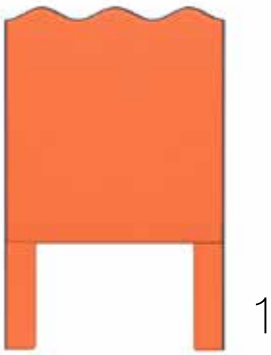
# ROOM TO GROW

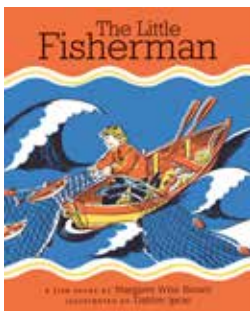
